



Inclusive Education for CASEL (co-ordinated approach to socially excluded localities) II

What is the aim of this call?

- Promoting inclusive education in the socially excluded localities
- Supporting nursery, primary and secondary schools in the implementation of individual integration
- Putting an emphasis on awareness-raising activities aimed at the public
- Supporting the creation of platforms between different stakeholders in education, and workshops

Who can apply for a grant?

- Private-law organizations the main purpose of which is not to make profit, carrying on an activity in the public interest
- Schools and educational establishments that are not funded by State organizational units
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- Contributory organisations that are not funded by State organizational units

How and when to apply?

Grant applications are submitted through IS KP14+ (<https://mseu.mssf.cz>):

- in the period from 11.10.2016 until the allocation is exhausted, till 29.12.2018 at the latest.

What is the amount of financial support?

- Allocation of the call: CZK 450 million
 - The minimum amount of financial support: CZK 3 million
 - The maximum amount of financial support: CZK 40 million
- The beneficiary's co-financing rate: **0% to 5%**
- The place of impact of the implemented projects is the territory of the Czech Republic except for the City of Prague

What activities are supported?

- Preschool education
- Preventing school failure:
 - **Thematic block I:** tutoring pupils at risk of school failure; guides for pupils - "older friends"; peer education; educational activities during the holidays; after-school clubs in schools and leisure facilities; visits to other schools with a group of pupils; career guidance
 - **Thematic block II:** Workshops for parents of pupils; cooperation with parents and awareness-raising activities; support for parents in dealing with teachers, social and health services; support for school guidance centres; involvement of parents in school activities; information and awareness-raising campaigns; support for active parents of pupils from disadvantaged backgrounds; pilot testing of inclusion coordinator positions in schools; trips for teachers

What target groups can be supported?

- **Mandatory target groups:**
 - Pupils/ children from socio-economically disadvantaged and culturally different background
 - Parents and custodians of children and pupils
- **Other target groups**
 - The staff of schools and educational establishments,
 - Pupils who are at risk of dropout
 - Children and pupils, if the project activities are aimed at the creation of an inclusive environment in a school, non-formal education establishment and in organizations providing leisure activities for children and youth.
 - Employees and volunteers of organisations operating in the field of education or assistance services and in the field of non-formal education and leisure time for children and youth, students of teacher training faculties and of programmes focused on education of children and pupils.
