



Strategic management of research, development and innovation at the national level II

(Call No. 02_16_024)

What is the aim of this call?

The aim of the call is to improve the quality of the strategic management of research, development and innovation at the national level. Strategic management will be strengthened mainly through the innovated management of the National Research and Innovation Strategy for Intelligent Specialization of the Czech Republic (hereinafter "National RIS3 Strategy") and through the related strengthening of the management of discovery of new entrepreneurial opportunities (so called Entrepreneurial discovery process) at the national level.

Who can apply for a grant?

The eligible applicant must be an organizational unit of the State and at the same time meet all the conditions specified in Chapter 5.2.1 of the Rules for Applicants and Beneficiaries - specific part.

How and when to apply?

Grant applications are submitted through IS KP14+ (<https://mseu.mssf.cz>) **in the period from 17. 07. 2019 till 31. 07. 2020, 14:00.**

What activities are eligible?

Obligatory activities:

- Project management
- Project evaluation
- Supportive tools of the National RIS3 strategy
- Organizational development and methodological support of National Innovation Platforms
- Development of methodological cooperation and competencies of the National and Regional RIS3 managing team

More details regarding the above-mentioned activities are defined in the text of the call (Chapter 5.1.1) and the Rules for Applicants and Beneficiaries – specific part (Chapter 5.2.4)

What is the amount of financial support?

- Allocation for the call: **CZK 60 000 000**
- Minimum amount of total eligible expenditure: CZK 5 000 000 Kč
- Maximum amount of total eligible expenditure: CZK 60 000 000

What target groups can be supported?

- Public administration staff in research, development and innovation
- Public administration staff (state administration and self-government)
- Staff of research organizations
- Researchers in the private sector
